"Johnny"/Loie Hollowell

#### **Gregory Kondos Gallery**

In a strong solo show, Loie Hollowell explores the idea that the more symmetrical a human face is, the more beautiful it appears to others. Using her own face as a guide, she tests the idea by drawing one-half of her visage, folding the paper and making a rubbing that completes the image. In the process, she subverts our notions of beauty in a series of playful yet compelling "portraits" that record a variety of mutations and moods. The exhibition continues through Oct. 31 at the Gregory Kondos Gallery, Fishbacher Fine Art Building, Sacramento City College, 3835 Freeport Blvd. (916) 558-2210.
